HOW TO EXERCISE THE EXTENSION WAIVER FOR CPD YEAR 2025

STEP	<u>Calculate Shortfall</u>
1	Log into your ePortfolio account at https://www.silecpdcentre.sg/Login/ to determine the quantum of your CPD Year 2025 Points shortfall. Make sure you have updated your ePortfolio with any Private CPD Points you obtained in CPD Year 2025. Note how many Public and/or Private CPD Points and/or MEC Points you need to make up. Remember, if you have obtained the minimum number of Public CPD Points, the remaining CPD Points may be fulfilled using

Tips on Exercising the Extension Waiver

As the CPD Points you wish to rely on under the Extension Waiver must be updated in ePortfolio <u>before</u> you lodge the Extension Waiver Notice, get in touch with the event provider if your ePortfolio has not been updated with any Public CPD Points you obtained after 2 weeks from the end of the event.

If you intend to renew your PC/FPC on 1 April 2026, it is recommended that you do not rely on Accredited CPD Activities which are scheduled any later than 15 March 2026 to fulfil any shortfall in your Public CPD Points Requirements. This is because the Public CPD Points obtained from attending such activities may not be updated in your ePortfolio by 31 March 2026 due to the time taken to process attendance records.

CPD Points obtained from a single CPD Activity cannot be split up and applied towards CPD Points requirements for different CPD Years, even if the CPD Activity takes place over multiple days or comprises separate sessions. E.g., if you attend a two-day conference and wish to rely on CPD Points from the same to fulfil your shortfall, the CPD Points from both Day 1 and Day 2 must be applied to your shortfall.

All CPD Activities you list in your Extension Waiver Notice will count towards your CPD Year 2025 Points Requirements, and you will no longer be able to rely on these activities for your CPD Year 2026 Requirements. You may wish to avoid listing additional activities on the Extension Waiver Notice from which you obtained any CPD Points in excess of your CPD Year 2025 shortfall, since those can be used for your CPD Year 2026 requirements instead.

If you make a mistake, you should re-submit the Extension Waiver Notice. You may submit the Extension Waiver Notice form multiple times before the expiry of 30 April 2026, but only the last submission will be considered.

Important Notes

Unless you lodge the Extension Waiver Notice, any CPD Points obtained during the extension period will count towards your CPD Year 2026 Points Requirements.

Successful lodgement of the Extension Waiver Notice does not automatically mean that you have validly exercised the Extension Waiver. It is only upon audit that the Institute may call on you to clarify the details of any Extension Waiver Notice lodged and provide documentary evidence of your compliance with your CPD Requirements.
