## YOU CAN UNDERTAKE E-LEARNING TO **OBTAIN PRIVATE CPD POINTS?**

### Why e-Learning?



e-Learning can be a convenient way to obtain your Private CPD Points. Many e-learning programmes are free or low-cost, and can be viewed virtually anywhere and at any time using a computer or a smartphone with internet access.

### **Points Calculation**



You may obtain 1 Private CPD Point for each hour of a video you review. The number of CPD points must be rounded up or down to the nearest full or 0.5 CPD Point. The video must be at least 20 minutes long.



#### e-Learning Need Not Relate to the Practice of Law

In addition to obtaining CPD Points from undertaking law-related e-learning, you can obtain CPD Points from undertaking non-law-related e-learning if the programme:

Comprises significant intellectual or practical content; and

Deals primarily with, and seeks to extend your knowledge or skill in at least one of the following areas:







Office productivity and management skills;





management Personal and development skills;

Presentation and communication skills;



Any non-legal specialist knowledge relevant to your practice needs.
